# House Activities Community Charity Program

## Information and Application



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## Student / Community House Charity Program

### Purpose

The purpose of the Community House Charity Program is to invite members of our Kyabram community to be part of a charity awareness program, where students can learn about and raise funds for local charities on an annual basis.

One charity per house group will be selected each year – a total of three charities per year.

**Brief Background** of our College Houses: Castles, Allan and Pine Grove

### Castles

Arthur Castles was the Deakin Shire Engineer and local architect and helped build the town's first water tower which supplied water to the school. There were many other notable buildings in Kyabram which Castles designed. The water drop mascot represents water – for the water tower.

### Allan

John Allan, who lived in Kyabram from 1873, became Premier of Victoria in 1924 and Australia's first Country Party premier. Allan was associated with the Kyabram Reform Movement, a conservative political organisation formed at the start of the 20th century. Mr. Allan's caricature is the Allan House Mascot.

### Pine Grove

Kyabram and district was a thickly forested area, the land was harsh and dry and the nearest source of water was the squatter's tank to the south of the town, with the Goulburn the closest river. Kyabram was only one of a few small settlements at that time, with Henley 3 miles South, Pine Grove one mile North-West, Taripta 3 miles North-East, and Lancaster to the East. Pine Grove is named for the last remaining white Cyprus pines in the district.

The Kyabram Historical Society president, Don Anderson, helped to develop the names before staff, students and school captains voted.

## Selection Panel

The Selection Panel will consist of:

- Principal Team for shortlisting
- Student Council / Students for final decision

After the charity submission closing date, applicants will be short listed. After this time, interviews may be held to determine the successful charities.

## Funding Use

Funds raised by the students for the local charities may be used at the discretion of the charity – in context with the application intention.

## Charity / Student Involvement

Member/s of the successful charities will need to be available on Thursday June 15<sup>th</sup> to speak with and /or be involved in the College House Activities Day. This will be an opportunity for successful charities to explain and promote their charity's cause for student and staff awareness.

## Eligibility Requirements

- Charities must be a locally based community charity.
- Successful applicants must be available at the College on June 15<sup>th</sup> 2017
